ITINERARY DETAIL

Day 1 — Day 1: Bangkok Arrival (-)

Warmly welcome you on arrival at Bangkok Suvarnabhumi International Airport. We will pick you up with a comfortable vehicle to the center of Bangkok to check-in your hotel, then take your time to have a rest after a long flight.

Day 2 — Day 3: Safari World in Bangkok (B)

Today, we take the whole day to explore **Safari World** – the must-visit place when you come to Thailand. It is the biggest natural opened- zoo with more than 75 mammal species, 300 bird species from Africa and Asia, and many unique animals all over the world.

The children must be very happy coming there.

The Safari World is divided into 2 main parts: **Safari Park and Marine Park.**

Safari Park raises and conserve many species of wild animal: lion, tiger, giraffe, zebra, deer, ... Wild animals are naturally raised so visitors can enjoy and take photos freely.

Marine Park raises typical marine animals, such as dolphins, sea lions,... Marine animals are well trained after careful training will give visitors the skill and beauty.

Back to the hotel and you are free to relax.

Day 3 — Day 4: Bangkok - Pattaya - Sanctuary of Truth (B)

After having breakfast, we drive to **Pattaya**, the first visit is **Sanctuary of Truth**, *a religious wooden building located along Pattaya Beach, which is cleverly built to withstand the wind and sunshine on the coast and style. The sanctuary style evokes Khmer architecture and hand-carved wooden sculptures, representative of the imperial setting in Angkor.*

Continue to Pattaya hotel to check-in and the rest of day is at leisure.

Day 4 — Day 5: Pattaya - Columbia Pictures Aquaverse (B)

Today we will spend all day at **Columbia Pictures Aquaverse**, *a new water theme park in Pattaya. Crazy water slides, incredible surfing, a wave pool, intergalactic races and many other adventures await you here.*

You've got the day free to explore the water park's 10 themed entertainment zones, each one offering an array of exhilarating water coasters and attractions. Each admission ticket includes a surf lesson, a

children's Cartoon Network tattoo, and access to the Toon Machine.

Day 9 — Day 2: Bangkok Full Day City Tour (B)

Today, we will take the whole day to explore Bangkok – the city of golden temples.

The first destination is the Grand Palace. This huge architectural complex is over 2 sq. kilometers, including 3 main sites: Royal Palace, Royal Office, and pagodas (Wat) built in the 1770s. Nowadays, the Grand Palace is no longer home of Thailand Royal, most national events take place there.

Wat Phra Kaew is the most outstanding architectural complex, built in 1785 when King Rama I moved the capital to Bangkok. The pagoda is famous not only for its beauty of unique Thailand Buddhist architecture but also for the sacred jade Buddha statue.

Nearby Grand Palace is Wat Pho – the oldest and biggest pagoda in Bangkok with more than 1000 Buddha statues and the huge sit-back Buddha in gold. This pagoda is also famous for being the birthplace of traditional Thai massage, since there is a traditional medicine school established in 1982, educating the arts of Thai massage.

We visit Wat Traimit. This pagoda is famous for its unique and historic beauty, and also for the huge golden Buddha statue. Thai people believe that the statue represents prosperity and purity, as well as strength and power.

After having lunch, we will board a boat to pay a visit along the Chao Phraya River, watching the life of local people close by.

On route, we stop at Wat Arun, known as the most beautiful pagoda in Bangkok not only for its location on the Chao Phraya's riverbank but also for the different architecture from other pagodas. The pagoda was decorated with glass pieces and Chinese ceramic, in a complicated style.

Return to the hotel and you are free to explore Bangkok by night.
